MISSISSAUGA NEWS ATHLETIC BURSARY PROGRAM - CRITERIA

The Mississauga Sports Council's Mississauga News Athletic Bursary Program will provide financial assistance to two student athletes per year (1 male and 1 female) to help offset the cost of post secondary school education. Each recipient will receive \$1,000.00 in bursary money.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to receive a bursary all of the following criteria must be met. A Candidate must:

- Be a resident of the City of Mississauga
- Be a graduating student from a secondary school
- Be enrolling in a recognized Canadian college or university
- Meet the admission standards of the college or university they are attending
- Be furthering their athletic career while attending their school of choice

HOW TO APPLY

1. Candidates must complete the attached application form.
2. Accompanying the application form, candidates must submit the following:
 - Two (2) letters of reference from their current school (on official school letterhead)
 - One letter of reference from a coach
 - Most current copy of candidate's Official School Transcript
 - Copy of current marks
 - In essay form, answer the question: "What are your long term goals and career objectives?" The length of the essay must be no more than one typed page.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED
